

Invest in infrastructure and upgrade to more water and energy efficient equipment

Equipment	Benefit/Rebate available	Potential Cost Savings
Food Steamers	Cash incentives up to \$1,500	Payback less than 2 years
Spray Heads	Efficient models save a gallon per minute	\$500-900 per year
Commercial Dishwasher	Energy Star models use 25% less energy and 52,000 less gallons of water per year	An average of \$850 per year on energy bills and \$200 per year on water bills
Cooling & Refrigeration	Rebates for up to 50% of costs for projects involving space cooling, refrigeration systems and industrial ice-makers	Energy Star buyers can expect to save \$150/year per ice machine, \$170/year per refrigerator and \$120 per freezer
Commercial Clothes Washer	\$500 rebates for efficient machines or up to 50% of large system improvements	An average of \$120 per washer per year
Toilet and Urinals	\$80 to \$120 rebates per fixture for new efficient models	Lowers water usage an average of 40%
Faucet Aerators	Inexpensive and simple to install	Reduce water use and cost of heating by as much as 50%
Plumbing-Tankless water heater	May be eligible for a federal energy tax credit	Save as much as 45-60% in energy costs
Commercial HVAC	Energy Star qualified light commercial HVAC equipment uses 7-10% less energy	Save \$3-4 per square foot for the life of the equipment
Sprinkler System	Rebates for upgrading existing automatic underground sprinkler systems or installing a “smart” controller on a new system	Cost savings associated with a typical annual reduction in water use of 25-40%
Lighting Retrofit	CFL light bulbs consume 75% less electricity than an incandescent bulb to produce the same amount of light and last anywhere from 4 to 15 times longer	Reduces lighting energy costs by more than 50%
Occupancy sensors	Turn lighting, heating, and cooling units on or off based on whether or not the room is occupied	Can reduce energy costs by as much as 50%
